HALE Mobile Outreach Venue

Further information and hire charges

HALE's mobile outreach venue is the perfect space for outreach projects and events at the heart of the community. It's designed to help you engage with new audiences and reach communities in a fresh way, offering all the facilities you need in one place.

Making a big impact wherever it goes, the mobile outreach venue is ideal for outreach projects, small group workshops, drop-in sessions and one-to-one consultations. Our Community Health Facilitator delivers the venue to your chosen location and is on hand to support your sessions as needed.

What's on board?

Front area

- Fully equipped cooking area with four induction hobs, electric fan oven, worktop space, fridge, sink and hot and cold water supply
- Lockable storage cupboards and removable notice boards
- Leather trimmed lounge seating area with table and stools
- Lockable storage and coat rack

Private consultation area

- Lockable sliding door
- Computer desk with laptop and printer (free broadband available)
- Toilet compartment with sink, mirror and lockable cupboard

The mobile outreach venue can fit six people comfortably for workshops or drop-in sessions, as well as the one-to-one consultation space. You can extend the space by using the outside awning, which can comfortably hold 15 people standing, or two tables.

While you are hiring the mobile outreach venue, you are welcome to display your materials and information on board, including using our leaflet holders.

In more detail...

How big is it?

The mobile outreach venue is 9.3 metres long, 2.5 metres wide, and approximately 3 metres high.

How big is the outside space?

The awning is 4 metres long and runs the length of the mobile outreach venue.

Do you provide chairs and tables for the outside area?

We provide two tables and two chairs; you are welcome to bring along additional outside furniture.

Does it have disabled access?

Yes – there is a ramp leading to the lounge and the consultation area.

Where can it be driven to?

We are happy to drive the venue to any location within 1.5 hours drive from Shipley, Bradford, and we charge 50 pence per mile after the first ten miles. For an indication of the areas we cover, see below.

Where can we park it?

You will need to check with your local authority for parking permissions, but this is usually free. Any parking area needs to be level with a hard surface. The bus can't be parked on grassed areas.

Can it transport people?

Unfortunately it can't – it's designed to be a venue rather than a vehicle for moving people about.

Hire Charges 2011

Volunteer Groups, Charities and Individuals	£ 50.00 per hour for first 3 hours 10% Discount for booking of 4 hours or more £300.00 for full day (7 hours) Block bookings of more than one day - please enquire
Other Users	£65.00 per hour for first 3 hours 10% Discount for booking of 4 hours or more £400.00 for full day (7 hours) Block bookings of more than one day - please enquire
Mileage	£ 0.50 per mile - inclusive of generator usage (first 10 miles free)

This package includes

- The venue delivered to your chosen location and set up for you
- Full use of the venue and all facilities including the cookers and laptop
- Our Community Health Facilitator's support during your session.

We ask for a deposit of £25.00 or 10% of the hire total, whichever is higher.

Additional development workers can be supplied at a cost of £25 per hour. HALE's development workers can deliver a range of healthy living sessions, including:

- Smoking cessation
- Sexual health and relationships (for young people and parents and carers)
- Chlamydia screening
- Oral health (for parents and under 5s)
- Weight, exercise and food advice
- Breastfeeding support

The venue is insured under public and product liability insurance. We are also insured for the vehicle while the venue is moving, and for the interior and fittings while the venue is static. If you are hiring the venue, you don't need to take out any additional insurance; however, if we are required to make an insurance claim as a result of damage sustained while you are hiring the bus, we will require you to pay a vehicle excess of £500.
